CMS (Sel) Alexander Garcia is the Superintendent, Lodging Division, Directorate of Operations, Headquarters Air Force Services Agency, Port San Antonio, Texas. In this position, he oversees the Air Force Lodging program encompassing 91 Air Force Inns worldwide comprised of over 31,000 bed spaces, staffed by 6,000 employees, and generating over 289 million dollars annually in operating revenues. He is responsible for developing and implementing standards, procedures, and programs required to deliver quality hospitality services to Air Force travelers balancing unique Air Force mission requirements. He is also responsible for researching and implementing new and emerging commercial hotel and lodging industry technologies and customer amenities.

Additionally, he provides reachback support to 91 installation-level lodging operations, problem resolution and functional management assistance to directly support 10 Major Commands and two Direct Reporting Units. SMSgt Alexander provides Air Force lodging functional and technical support to 26 installations involved with Joint Basing.

CMS (Sel) Garcia grew up in Bronx, N.Y., and is a graduate of the Bronx High School of Science. He entered the Air Force in December 1986. His background includes numerous leadership roles at squadron, major command, combatant command and Headquarters Air Force levels. He has been stationed at locations in New Jersey, California, Florida and Texas. Additionally, he served overseas in Sicily, Spain, Singapore, the Republic of Korea, the United Kingdom, Qatar, and Iraq. He has worked a variety of Services duties. Sergeant Garcia served as a superintendent of a Force Support Flight before becoming the Superintendent of Air Force Lodging.
